Attendance And Punctuality	Encourage and reward good attendance and punctuality. Follow up any regular or unexpected absences.	Attend school every day and arrive in good time for the start of lessons.	Ensure that my child attends school and is punctual.
Class and homework	Plan carefully and teach all aspects of the national Curriculum to meet each child's needs. Set appropriate tasks and mark the work regularly. Send home work that is incomplete or of unacceptable quality for completion. Communicate with parents and give details of home Learning.	Listen carefully and play an active part in lessons. Work hard to do my best. Know and understand what my targets for improvement are and work hard to achieve them. Complete any unfinished unsatisfactory work at home when necessary. Remember to complete all my Home Learning to the best of my ability and hand it in on time.	Take an active interest in my child's work at school. Encourage my child to do his / her best at school. Communicate with teachers regarding any problems or successes with work at school or home. Make sure that homework or unfinished tasks are completed and handed in on time.
Behaviour	Insist on high standards of behaviour and politeness at all times both in and out of the classroom. Inform parents immediately of any persistent behavioural problems	Behave well in and around school, on the way to school and on the route home. Follow the school rules, behaviour and anti-bullying policy.	Encourage my child to follow the school rules, behaviour and ant bullying policy. Support the school's expectations of children's and adults behaviour
Pastoral Support	Listen and respond quickly to any concerns or problems Give emotional and pastoral support when necessary.	Let my teacher know if I have any worries	Let the school know quickly of any concerns or problems that may affect my child's learning.
Links with school	Hold parents' evenings and information meetings at regular intervals. Report regularly on progress and attendance. Inform parents of any concerns or problems at school. Attend parents' evenings Read school letters and reply as and when necessary. Support the school in helping my child to achieve his / her best in academic and social aspects of school.
Extracurricular activities and events at school	Arrange and organise a range of extra-curricular activities for pupils at lunchtimes and after school. Organise regular productions and events to which parents and carers are invited.	Find out about the opportunities that are open to me, and ask my parents' permission to take part in any after-school activities. Once joined, attend clubs or activities regularly, letting organisers know if I cannot attend.	Encourage my child to attend extracurricular activities. Support school teams and clubs. Support events for parents such as Church Services, assemblies, concerts and productions.
