Attendance And Punctuality	<p>Encourage and reward good attendance and punctuality.</p> <p>Follow up any regular or unexpected absences.</p>	<p>Attend school every day and arrive in good time for the start of lessons.</p>	<p>Ensure that my child attends school and is punctual.</p>
Class and homework	<p>Plan carefully and teach all aspects of the national Curriculum to meet each child's needs.</p> <p>Set appropriate tasks and mark the work regularly.</p> <p>Send home work that is incomplete or of unacceptable quality for completion.</p> <p>Communicate with parents and give details of home Learning.</p>	<p>Listen carefully and play an active part in lessons.</p> <p>Work hard to do my best.</p> <p>Know and understand what my targets for improvement are and work hard to achieve them.</p> <p>Complete any unfinished unsatisfactory work at home when necessary.</p> <p>Remember to complete all my Home Learning to the best of my ability and hand it in on time.</p>	<p>Take an active interest in my child's work at school.</p> <p>Encourage my child to do his / her best at school.</p> <p>Communicate with teachers regarding any problems or successes with work at school or home.</p> <p>Make sure that homework or unfinished tasks are completed and handed in on time.</p>
Behaviour	<p>Insist on high standards of behaviour and politeness at all times both in and out of the classroom.</p> <p>Inform parents immediately of any persistent behavioural problems</p>	<p>Behave well in and around school, on the way to school and on the route home.</p> <p>Follow the school rules, behaviour and anti-bullying policy.</p>	<p>Encourage my child to follow the school rules, behaviour and anti-bullying policy.</p> <p>Support the school's expectations of children's and adults behaviour</p>
Pastoral Support	<p>Listen and respond quickly to any concerns or problems</p> <p>Give emotional and pastoral support when necessary.</p>	<p>Let my teacher know if I have any worries</p>	<p>Let the school know quickly of any concerns or problems that may affect my child's learning.</p>
Links with school	<p>Hold parents' evenings and information meetings at regular intervals.</p> <p>Report regularly on progress and attendance.</p> <p>Inform parents of any concerns or problems at school.</p>	<p>Take any information, newsletters or personal letters home to my parent/s</p> <p>Talk to my teachers or parent/s about anything that is worrying me that might affect my school work or happiness.</p>	<p>Attend parents' evenings</p> <p>Read school letters and reply as and when necessary.</p> <p>Support the school in helping my child to achieve his / her best in academic and social aspects of school.</p>
Extracurricular activities and events at school	<p>Arrange and organise a range of extra-curricular activities for pupils at lunchtimes and after school.</p> <p>Organise regular productions and events to which parents and carers are invited.</p>	<p>Find out about the opportunities that are open to me, and ask my parents' permission to take part in any after-school activities.</p> <p>Once joined, attend clubs or activities regularly, letting organisers know if I cannot attend.</p>	<p>Encourage my child to attend extracurricular activities.</p> <p>Support school teams and clubs.</p> <p>Support events for parents such as Church Services, assemblies, concerts and productions.</p>
